New Business

Enrollment Update: Jennifer Moore presented the MUW enrollment profile. All data will be published in fact book on the IR website. The fact book will be published in late fall except for credit hour production information. If specific departmental information is needed, please request it from Jennifer.

CLA & NSSE Results: Mark Bean presented the CLA & NSSE results.

NSSE: MUW had a good NSSE response rate and scores were high. NSSE is a perception survey. MUW identifies the peer group. Ours includes about 17 institutions and is identified by PELL funding percentages.

QEP/NSSE: trend shows that students are not using numerical information. QEP will be forming a focus group to review NSSE questions. Responses could differ based on students' disciplines.

CLA+: Freshman test in the Fall, Seniors test in the Spring. There are two parts: performance task (narrative analysis) and selected response (25 multiple choice). MUW is the only MS school giving the CLA+, so we are being compared to vastly different schools. Students are performing at expected goal.

Commencement Survey: 242 students completed the survey. Survey was more streamlined this year and a full academic year was covered (August, December, May).
