OPERATING DETAILS:

1. The function of the Scholarship Appeals Committee is to consider appeals by students who have lost their renewable university scholarship(s) awarded by the Office of Admissions. When extenuating circumstances exist, the committee can approve for the award(s) to be reinstated with certain academic requirements or conditions. The decisions of the committee are not subject to review or change by any other university authority.
2. Membership consists of one faculty member from each College/School, as appointed by the Dean. The Registrar, Director of Financial Aid, Director of University Accounting, and the Director of the Honors College will serve as members of the Committee. Membership of the Committee will be unpublished.
