


#### Notable Gains and Losses in Degrees

- Gains
  - 171% BAS degrees
  - 95% Business Admin
  - 86% Kinesiology
  - 80% Psychology
  - 80% Elementary Ed
  - 58% Public Health Ed

- Losses
  - -15% BSN

CONCLUSION: Looking back over the last 5 years, all other programs were stable. They showed no significant gain or loss relative to degree production.
