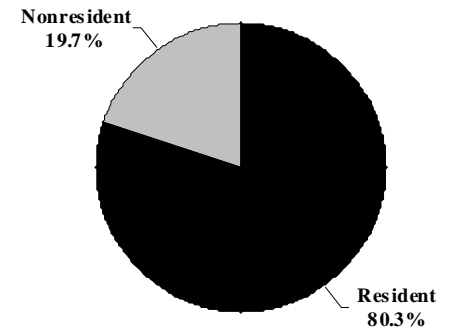
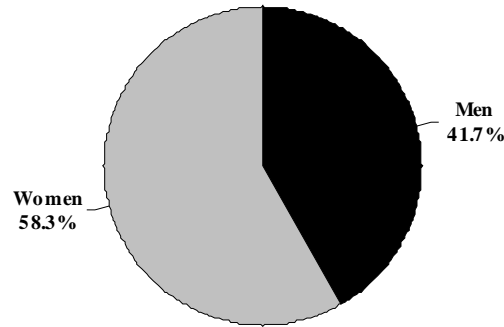
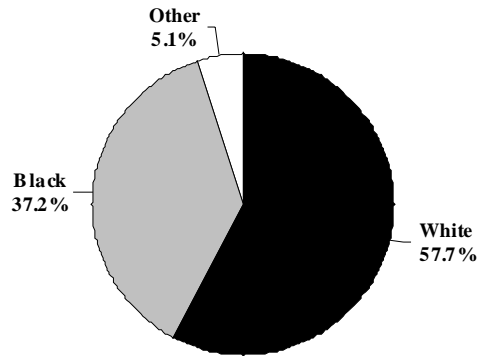
Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment

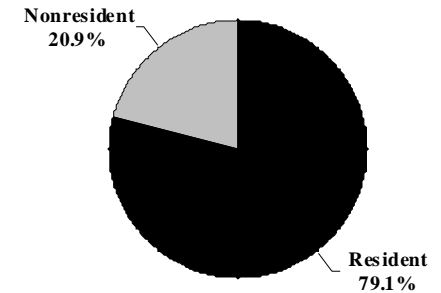
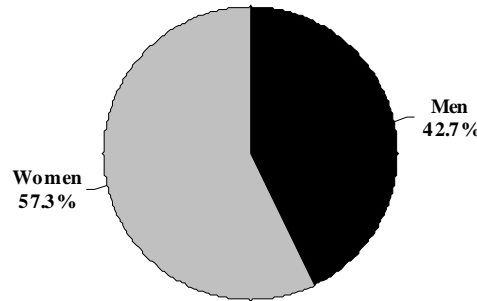
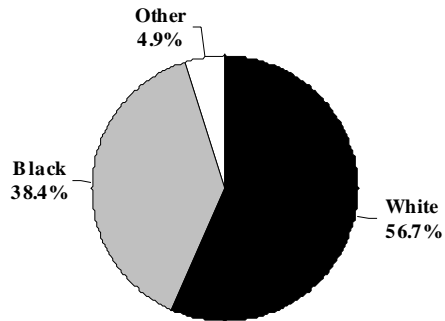


Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment



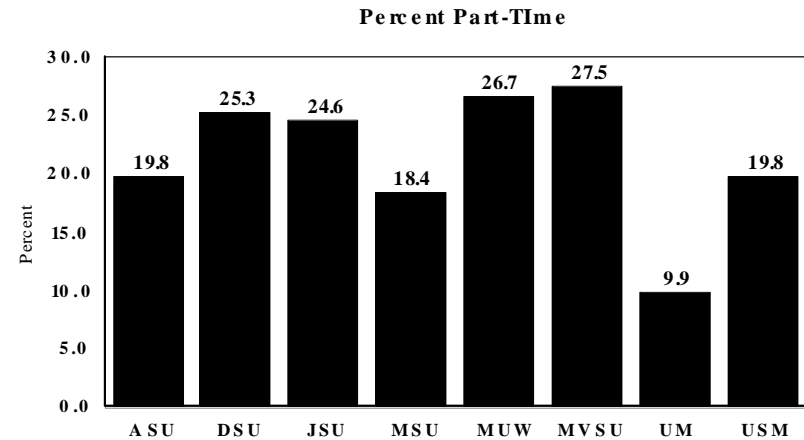
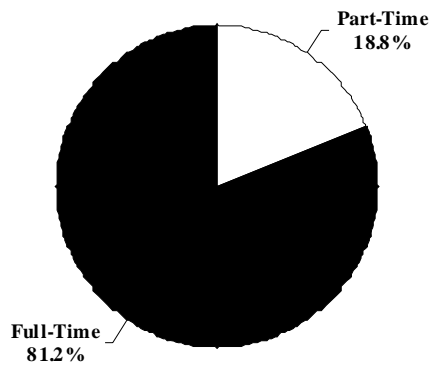

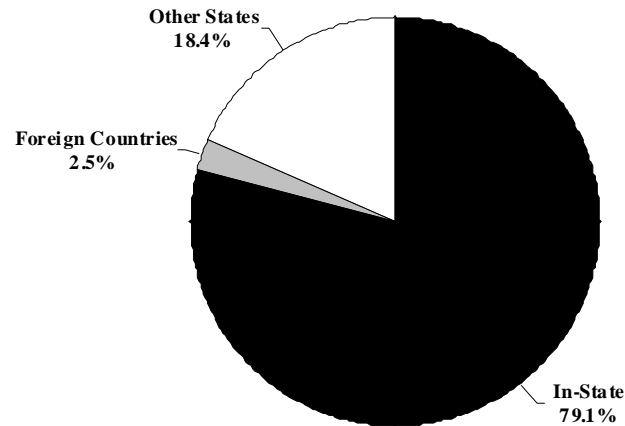

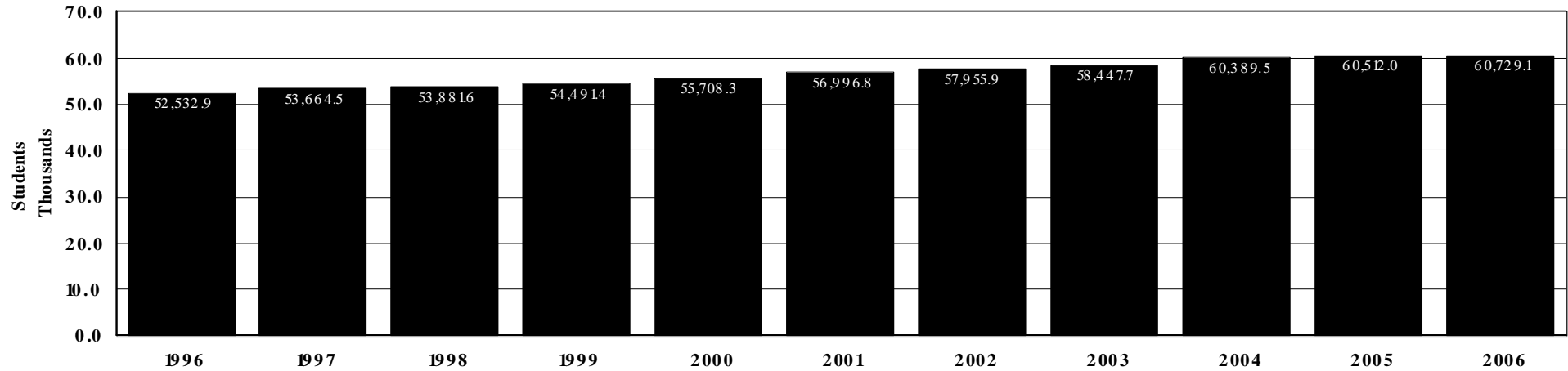

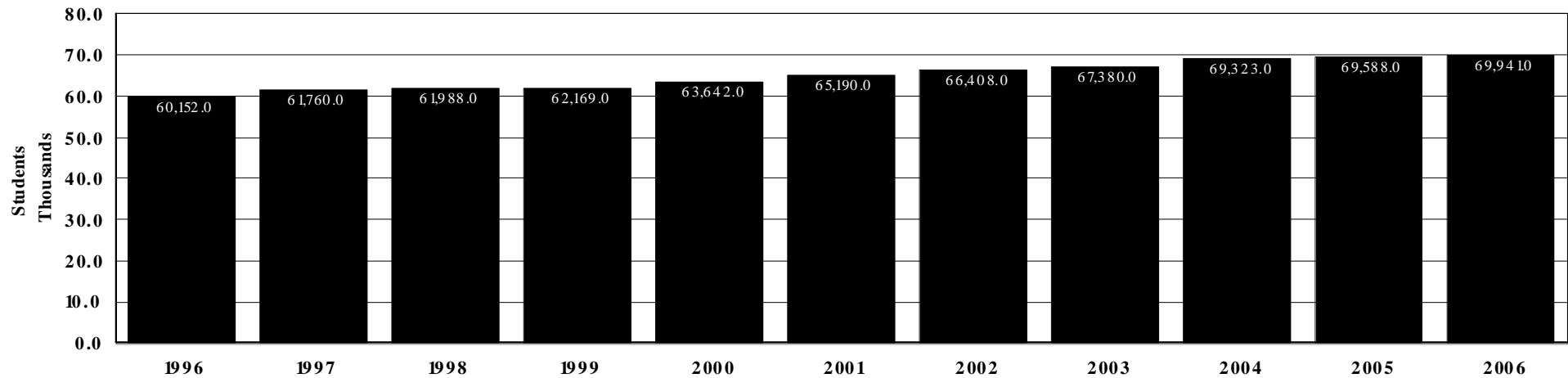
# SYSTEM TOTAL FTE AND TOTAL HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT

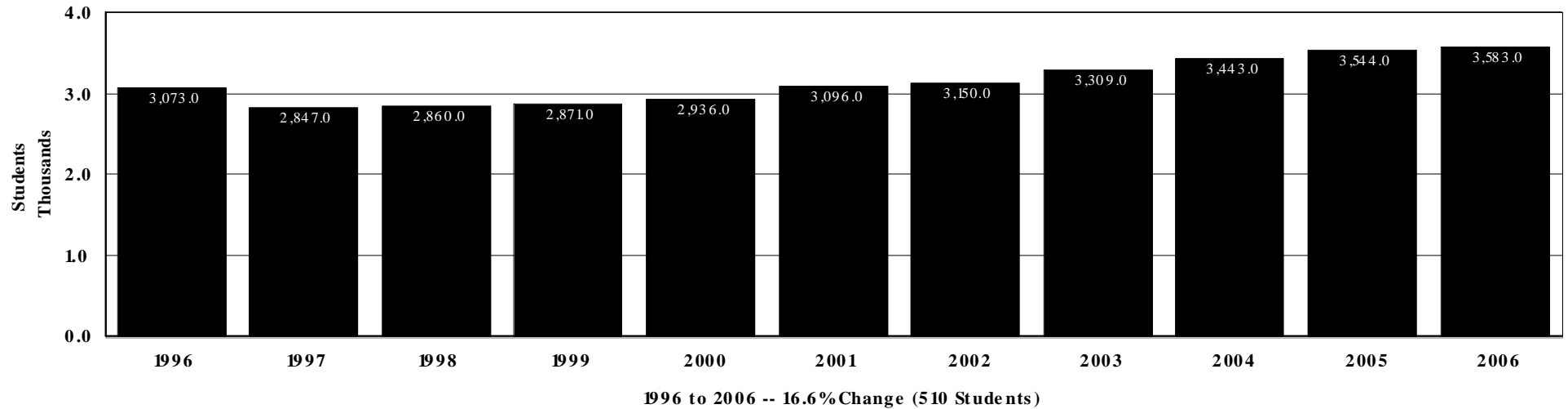

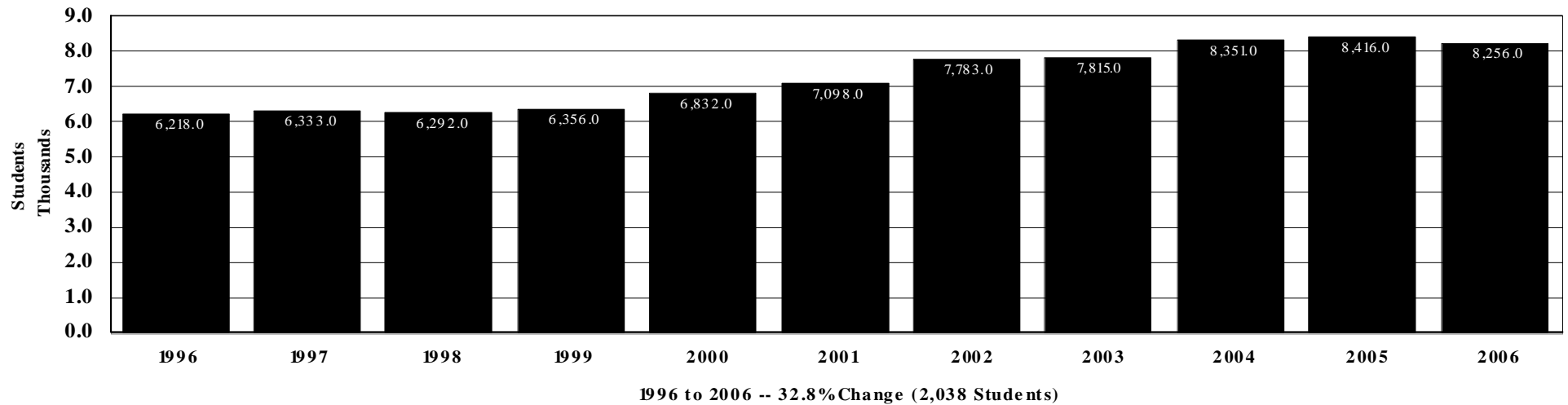

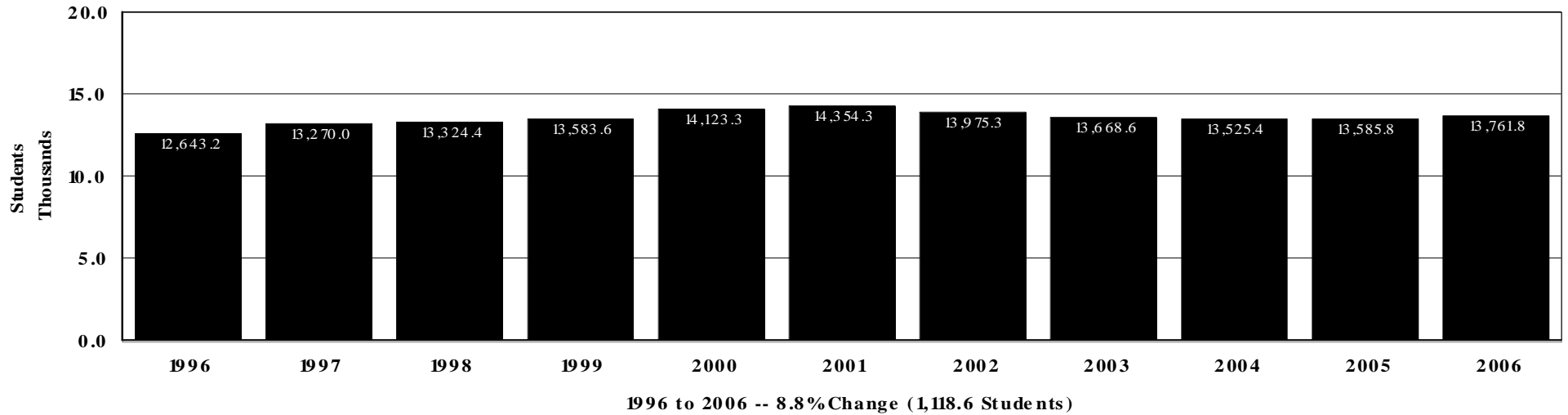

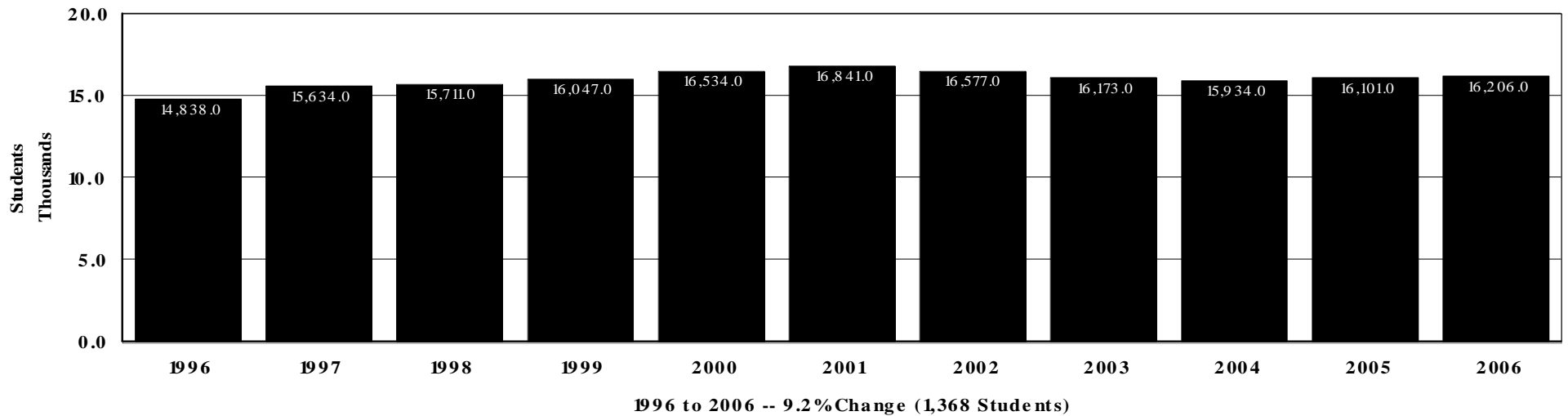

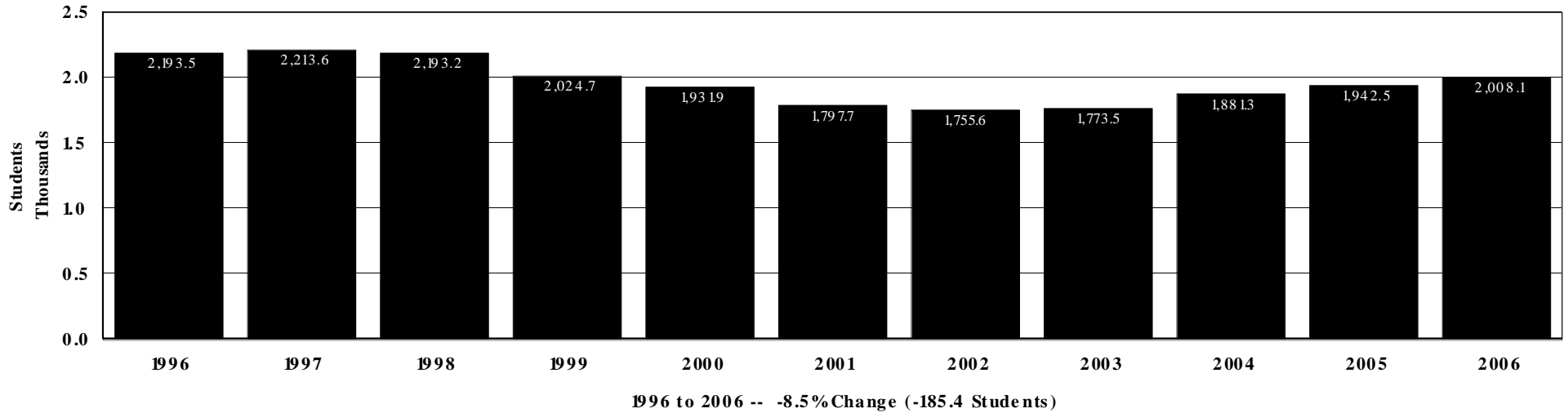

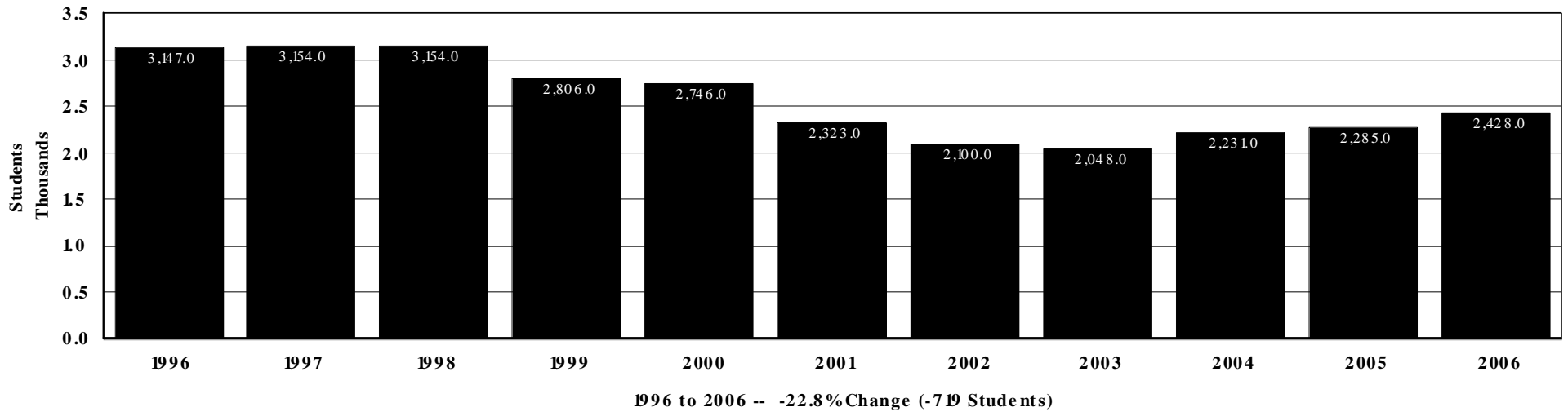
