Bulletin Issued: Wednesday, February 14, 2018

A Columbus man has been charged for the Dec. 13, 2017, armed robbery on the campus of Mississippi University for Women and two other burglaries in Columbus that occurred in February 2018.

Dominico Joeta Saddler, 33-years-old, of Seventh Avenue South in Columbus, has three total charges and is being held in the Lowndes County Adult Detention Center.

The MUW incident charge was brought from the Lowndes County Sheriff's Office for the alleged armed robbery of an MUW staff member outside Fant Hall on the MUW campus. Saddler was identified from a still-shot from a video camera. That charge is armed robbery.

The Columbus Police Department charged Saddler with burglary of a commercial building, cars, etc... and burglary by breaking and entering a residence following a separate incident. While serving the first warrant for burglary of a car, Saddler ran from officers and a foot chase followed. Saddler then broke into a residence in the area in Columbus. He was held by the police and the homeowner.

Bond for the burglary charge is \$75,000. Bond for the armed robbery has not been set as of Wednesday afternoon.

MUW President Jim Borsig said, "I appreciate the interagency collaboration between the Columbus Police Department, the Lowndes County Sheriff's Office and the MUW Police Department. The good work by all three agencies led to this arrest."
