Bulletin Issued: Wed., Jan. 25, 2022

Updated as of Jan. 26, 2022, 8:30 a.m.: The Columbus Police Department arrested Braylin Christopher Edinburgh Tuesday, Jan. 25. Details about Edinburgh's arrest can be found on the Columbus Police Department's official Facebook page.

On Monday, Jan. 24 at 7:42 p.m., a W-Alert was issued to The W's campus community that the Columbus Police Department was looking for Braylin Christopher Edinburgh, who is wanted for aggravated assault off campus. The W-Alert was issued because it was reported by CPD that Edinburgh was associated with a current W student.

Today, upon further investigation both police departments learned that Edinburgh had been seen on campus, resulting in a coordinated search of Jones Hall with the MUW Police Department and CPD. The suspect was not found and is not believed to be on campus.

Following their investigation, authorities determined there was no immediate threat to campus.
