Bulletin Issued: Friday, Sept. 10, 2021

On Friday, Sept. 10 at 4:20 p.m., the MUW Police Department was notified that the Columbus Police Department responded to a home invasion involving a firearm near campus. CPD reported that the suspect left the home in a white Volkswagen with an unknown direction of travel.

As a precaution, a W-Alert was distributed to the campus community advising everyone to go into lockdown.

Upon further investigation, CPD notified the MUW Police Department that the incident was a domestic dispute with no firearm involved. The campus lockdown was lifted.

Individuals are encouraged to remain cautious of their surroundings and report any suspicious activity to law enforcement. Suspicious activity should be reported to (662) 241-7777 or 911 immediately!

In the event an emergency situation arises, either on or off campus, that constitutes an ongoing or continuing threat, a campus wide alert will be issued through the University's text messaging system called W-Alert to students, faculty and staff.
