On Monday, March 25, 2019, the MUW Police Department received reports of suspicious individuals walking through parking lots and pulling vehicle door handles. MUW officers were able to locate the individuals. After speaking to the individuals, the Columbus Police Department was contacted to assist with the investigation. Officers determined that the individuals were responsible for an auto burglary reported to the MUW Police Department earlier that evening.

All four individuals were taken into custody by the Columbus Police Department with charges pending.
