Bulletin Issued: July 9, 2019

Earlier today, Martin Hall initiated a lock down after receiving information of a potential physical threat to an individual in their building from a non-university affiliated person. University police promptly responded and have taken appropriate steps to assess the situation. UPD has determined there is no continuing threat. They will continue to take steps to ensure continued safety on campus. As precautionary measure, entrances and exits to perimeter gates have been limited. The lockdown has been lifted.

W-Alert Reminder

In the event that a situation arises, either on or off campus, that constitutes an ongoing or continuing threat, a campus wide “timely warning” will be issued. The warning will be issued through the University’s text messaging system called W-Alert to students, faculty and staff.
